For weeks Athletics South Africa President Leonard Chuene denied that gender tests were done on Caster Semenya, the 800m world champion.

In an explosive interview with the former national team coach, Wilfred Daniels reveals what really went on. He says that some sex tests did indeed take place in South Africa before Berlin and that ASA were advised not to let Semenya run, but went ahead anyway. Emails confirm that ASA's top management authorised the tests.
