This Week On 3rd Degree: Tuesday 15 November @ 8pm **Tracking The Blood Trail**

Dubbed the 'Station Strangler', a man named Norman Simons, was jailed for life 11 years ago. The gruesome murders of 21 young boys and a man, who were found sodomised and strangled to death on the Cape Flats, shocked the nation.

Simons was convicted of only one murder, not enough evidence linked him to the other crimes. In 1994 Advocate Koos Louw agreed to defend Simons, believing him innocent. However, the court found Simons guilty and sentenced him to 25 years.

To this day Louw refuses to give up on a crusade to free his client. That crusade is now fuelled by new DNA tests which could prove that Simons was not the killer.

Meanwhile, an inquest into the deaths of three boys believed murdered by the 'Station Strangler' begins in December.
