After the Call To Entry Phase has closed the audition process will commence. Through this process a total of twelve contestants between the ages of 21 and 40 will be selected from around South Africa. We are looking for competitors who think they are up to it, are charismatic, larger than life and have loads of sex appeal!

The twelve contestants who are short-listed will arrive in a rudimentary camp that will serve as home for the two-week duration of the shoot. They will sleep in a large army tent, eat in a communal canteen and share outdoor showers.

There will be no communication with the outside world. Phones, television sets or other luxuries will not be permitted.

Two camera crews will film the contestants' every move. Every conversation will be recorded.

The contestants will have to endure many hardships including two stunts each day that are compulsory for all. The contenders must be prepared for the unexpected. Nothing will be revealed until they arrive on set! The nature of the challenges is either gross 'edible' or physical. The contestants will be instructed to perform either as a group, partnership or as individuals. After the two compulsory stunts have been performed the process of elimination begins. At certain intervals in the competition, our candidates will have to leave the game. Only the fearless and resilient will survive until the final challenge! This year our contestants will endure two stunts and one edible per day, everyday.
