e Press Alert: "Little Angel" - the documentary they didn't want you to see.

Introduction:

On Tuesday at 8pm 3rd Degree and e.tv brings you “Little Angel” – a documentary on the Jordon-Leigh Norton (Baby Jordan) murder. The documentary has exclusive interviews with the Jordan family that were conducted a week after the killing. This 3rd Degree documentary was scheduled to air last year, but e.tv was prevented from screening it after the Directorate of Public Prosecutions obtained an urgent High Court interdict to halt the broadcast. e.tv appealed against the interdict on the basis that it created a dangerous precedent where the media could be prevented from reporting on pending criminal proceedings until such reports had been vetted by the State. The state has withdrawn its objection to e.tv screening the programme on the basis that the trial is already underway. e.tv has nevertheless persisted in its appeal against the ruling as the channel believes that the ruling amounted to pre-censorship and was a threat to freedom of expression.

Debora Patta, e.tv Editor-in-Chief, said: “The point we are trying to make is that we are still against the principle where the State may pre-approve news before it is aired and that we will contest this.”

** “Little Angel” airs on 3rd Degree on Tuesday 7 February and replaces “Class Dismissed”. “Class Dismissed” will be re-scheduled.

Little Angel

"I kissed her goodbye, and I said I'll see you later, but she was fast asleep. And that's the last time I saw her": Natasha Norton's last words to her baby girl.

Just six months old, innocent, beautiful and yet already the victim of a brutal crime. **Baby Jordan Leigh Norton** was at her home in Lansdowne with her nanny and uncle when four men posing as couriers stormed into the house.

After tying up the two adults, the would be robbers proceeded to stab the little girl in the neck.

Expecting an arrest of the four, the public were shocked to the core when a 24-year-old woman, said to be the girlfriend of Baby Jordan's father, was charged with masterminding the baby's murder.

Tonight on **3rd Degree**, Jordan's nanny and uncle explain in detail what they went through on that fateful morning - first not knowing where the baby was, and then their shocking discovery.

"I just looked over at my bed and I saw Jordan's legs, 'cause she had a pillow over her head - I didn't know what to expect - I lifted the pillow up - her eyes were closed and she had blood all around her neck. Then I picked her up and I didn't know what to do 'cause there was blood dripping all over the floor" - Dylan Norton.

The accused, Dina Rodriguez is back in court - could this woman who friends describe as a wonderful, loving, caring, sweet-natured girl have committed such an evil, heinous crime.
