In this Sunday's episode JUDGE FOR YOURSELF, the issue of xenophobia is highlighted by the recent spate of violent attacks on the Somali community in Masiphumelele. The constitution protects the poor and vulnerable sectors of the community, including foreign refugees.

There is evidence that South Africans are intolerant of outsiders and African immigrants in particular. Government and other agencies have an important task in convincing South Africans that a more open and inclusive immigration policy is in the interests of the country
