Independence of the Judiciary **Sunday 19 March at 6.30pm**

Join Judge Dennis Davis on Sunday 19 March at 6.30pm for a discussion on the Independence of the Judiciary. Parliament is considering an amendment to the constitution that would give the Minister of Justice more power over our courts. The proposed legislation has led to an ugly turf war between the judiciary and government.

Judge Dennis Davis explains why the independence of the judiciary is important for every South African. He will be joined in the studio by Advocate George Bizos (Human Rights Lawyer) and Professor Shadrack Gutto (Director of the Centre for African Renaissance Studies, UNISA).

In addition, e.tv formed a partnership with Research Surveys, a leading market research company. Research Surveys will conduct polls throughout the country – across all race, age, metro and rural groups – for a credible study of people's opinions on these issues. The poll results will be made available to the public after each show.
