Let's Fix It

The Mndoza crèche just outside Newcastle, KwaZulu-Natal, is the focus of the Let's Fix it team this week. The crèche cares for 30 children between two to five years of age. Some of the concerns that the facility faces include a lack of basic food requirements for the children, who often arrive with no food.

Then there's the lack of clean drinking water, as well as the fact that there is no playground or any form of stimulation for the children. The Let's Fix It team will assist by providing educational toys and training, they will paint the interior of the crèche, give the children a party while the crèche is being redecorated and provide over 100 chickens and support equipment.

A portable start-up kit with educational toys will be donated. In addition, teachers and parents will receive training so that the toys are used effectively. The local municipality will provide fresh water until they install a proper water tap and they will provide a jungle-gym for the children to play on.
