### **Let's Fix It**

This week the Let's Fix It team visits Kulelani in Phalaborwa, which is in the Limpopo Province. Gloria Khoza founded the Phukwane Charity Organisation to help support families who have been affected by HIV/Aids, unemployment and migrant labour practises.

She helps over 64 families and keeps sustains them using her own salary as well as donations from the local community and some businesses. In addition, Gloria started an early learning centre for orphans and a sewing project to earn an income for their members.

They have secured a piece of land on which to operate, but need space and equipment to run the sewing project effectively, as well as food donations to cover daily needs while the sewing project is starting-up.

There is a five-room hut from where they run the crèche and prepare meals for members. Furthermore, they need basic kitchen equipment, as well as beds and vital household goods to relieve some of the financial and infrastructure challenges.

Let's Fix It helps with a wendy-house in which to start the sewing project, they supply sewing machines, kitchen and crèche equipment and food to keep them going them going until the sewing project starts making money.
