In this episode, Let's Fix It visits East London. Here they connect with Sipehelele Mbebe, an A grader in maths and science, who could not complete his university degree due to a lack of money.

Instead of just becoming another dropout, he decided to do volunteer work and assist a group of local school pupils with maths and science lessons.

He started the Free Mathematics Project (FMP) and along with other volunteers, they provide classes for their community three times a week in a large classroom, especially built.

Initially, they focussed on lessons for Grade 11 and 12 pupils, as well as young adults, but now there's no age limit.

The FMP, however, is in need of an extensive fix to their makeshift classroom, as well as vital extra educational materials.

Let's Fix It assists in supplying instructive materials to augment their teaching efforts and also renovate the ramshackle classroom in which they spend such valuable time.

But the cherry on the cake, is when Let's Fix It comes to the rescue and helps source funding to cover the costs for Sipehelele to complete his degree.
