DOCUMENTARY **SHE STOLE MY FOETUS** **SUNDAY 12 + 19 NOVEMBER AT 6.30PM**

e.tv exclusively brings you a chilling documentary examining foetal theft, one of the most shocking crimes of our time. She Stole My Foetus, produced by the esteemed British production house, October Films, is a fascinating and disturbing documentary film.

There will be two episodes, the first one on Sunday night 12 November at 6.30pm and the second installment the following Sunday 19 November at 6.30pm.

To date there have been seven cases of foetal theft – which involves the heartless murder of a pregnant woman – in order to cut out her unborn child. In addition, a disturbing pattern is forming. The killers are also women, with no history of violence or abuse.

The murders are always pre-meditated and the killers often maintain a fictional pregnancy for eight months, as they target their victim and plan their crime.

She Stole My Foetus looks at three cases to find an explanation for why these women commit these crimes. They examine the case of Elijah Evans, who was cut out of his mother's womb and abducted by his mother's murderer – by a woman who had befriended her and wanted a child.

They also consider other similar crimes of foetal abduction, all committed by egocentric women with children, who could have no more, but were in vulnerable relationships where they believed having a child would make them more secure.
