According to the website, Wikipedia, Star Trek collectively refers to six science-fiction television series spanning 726 episodes, ten motion pictures, in addition to hundreds of novels, video games, and other works of fiction, all set within the same fictional universe created by Gene Roddenberry in the mid 1960s.

It depicts an optimistic, almost utopian future in which humanity has overcome sickness, racism, poverty, intolerance and warfare on Earth, and has united with other intelligent species in the galaxy. The central characters explore the galaxy, discovering new worlds and encountering new civilizations, while helping to promote peace and understanding. "Star Trek" (or sometimes merely "Trek") is one of the most popular names in the history of science fiction entertainment, and one of the most popular franchises in television history.

Now e.tv brings you the Star Trek Movie Festival, kicking off with *The Motion Picture*. Patrolling in their own territory, three powerful Klingon cruisers are suddenly confronted by an unknown and awesome intruder. Their own weapons prove useless against a foe unlike anything ever seen in this, the 23rd Century. One by one, the Klingon spaceships are hit. Each is instantly destroyed.

Star Trek: The Motion Picture is the first feature film based on the popular *Star Trek* science fiction television series. It is often referred to as *ST:TMP* or *TMP*. The film is regarded as one of the best of the series and the one film that most accurately reflected Trek creator Gene Roddenberry's vision of the future.
