The Rough Cut : Sunday 7 May at 6.30pm **Real stories, real people behind them**

The Rough Cut, a current affairs programme on e.tv, returns for a second season on Sunday 7 May at 6.30pm. It replaces Judge for Yourself, which will return for a new season later this year. Every week an eNews reporter will produce a mini-documentary on the behind the scenes adventures, reportage, footage and emotions involved in one of their high-profile stories.

Viewers will experience the drama of newsroom editorial meetings, camera shoots and harrowing deadlines of the day – all in the life of a television journalist. Anne-Marie Hanna and Deon Kloppers produce the show, and they promise to let viewers in on the scandal and intrigue that happen on the side of the camera viewers don't normally get to see.

Some of the stories they'll tackle include: Nicky Greenwall's take on the Red Carpet, Annika Larsen's investigation into the power of television, Ayesha Ismail's compelling coverage of the Baby Jordan trial, Iman Rapetti's examination of where public interest warrants invasion of privacy, and Charlene Stanley's frank look at Aids reporting in Lesotho.
