Behind the scenes at the Baby Jordan Trial

On 5 June 2005 police are alerted to a housebreak in a quiet road in Cape Town. Hours later, six month old baby Jordan Leigh Norton is certified dead at a nearby doctor's surgery, and two days afterwards the girlfriend of the baby's biological father, 24-year-old Dina Rodrigues, is arrested.

A year later the real life drama is still unfolding. This week in *The Rough Cut* Cape Town reporter, Ayesha Ismail narrates the story of the Baby Jordan Trial. After almost two decades of journalism it is unlike any story she has ever covered before.

She shares the challenges, the sadness and the lessons she has taken from her experience of South Africa's first contract murder trial on the Rough Cut. Real Stories. Real people behind them. This Sunday 2 July at 6.30pm.
