Let's Fix It is a weekly reality series in which the well-liked presenter Soli Philander is challenged to fix people's problems. In the short time since its inception, the Let's Fix It team has assisted in helping a diverse group of people with computers, wheelchairs, food, house-repairs, medical assistance and much more.

In this episode the team visits Johannesburg. A retired couple's dreams are shattered when the husband suffers a massive stroke, leaving him wheelchair bound. He has lost his ability to speak and is often emotional when he contemplates a life of dependence and silence. The couple now lives off the last of their savings.

Then there is the lady, who sent a letter asking for new blankets and heaters. She hasn't bought new blankets for her family for 13 years.

Finally Soli visits a family who was devastated by the loss of the husband and father of the household. He was also the breadwinner. The mother had requested school clothes for her five daughters and made an emotional appeal for a dress for her eldest daughter to wear to her upcoming matric dance. It was a cry for help that could not be ignored, creating a challenge for Soli that quickly escalated into something more daunting than he had imagined.
