### **Let's Fix It: Tuesday 7 June at 8.30pm**

Let's Fix It is a half-hour, weekly reality series in which popular presenter Soli Philander is challenged to fix people's problems. Since its inception, the Let's Fix It team has assisted in helping many people alleviate the stress of poverty and hardship - with computers, wheelchairs, food, house-repairs, medical assistance and much more.

In this episode: Noxolo Floshe is a young woman putting herself through college, but every day is a stark and painful reminder of the difference between her and her fellow students - for Noxolo cannot afford more than the clothes on her back. The loss of self-esteem can be damaging to anyone, not least a young woman surrounded by peers who, in her eyes, all look much better than her. When Let's Fix It received a letter asking to buy Noxolo a new wardrobe, the team swung into action. But it wasn't going to be easy.

The Let's Fix It team also assists a community worker in Macassar and ballroom dancers from Retreat in Cape Town.
